## **Product Recall Information Notice**

Hellenic Food Authority (EFET) and more specifically its Regional Directorate in Thessaly, following Official Food Control and in collaboration with the Chemical Division of the General Chemical State Laboratory in Volos, requested the recall/withdrawal of jam due to presence of the preservative sorbic acid. Sorbic acid is an authorized food additive although not permitted to be used in this food category.

## The product being recalled is:

Plum jam with trade name "Μαρμελάδα Δαμάσκηνο Ανεμώνα Γαρδικίου – Plum jam Anemona Gardikiou" in package of 500 g, with best before date **31/12/2012**. The product is produced and packaged by the «Women's Gardikiou Agricultural Association» based in Pigi Trikalon.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product are asked not to consume it. Photo of the product is given below.
