Product Recall “Pariza NIKAS for toast, cooked”

EFET has sampled cooked pariza (salami) with trade name “Cooked Pariza NIKAS for toast” (in Greek: “Πάριζα ΝΙΚΑΣ για τoστ βραστή”) after official control based on complaint.

The sample originated from a 1.718 kg package (stick shaped salami) (in Greek: “μπαστούνι”, pronounced: “bastouni”), with best before date: 04.06.2013, code: 2000000001, 00144, produced / packaged by NIKAS AVEE company based at the 22nd km of the Athens - Lamia National Road, Agios Stefanos (in Greek: “ΝΙΚΑΣ ΑΒΕΕ”).

Horse DNA was detected in the aforementioned product based on laboratory analysis (less than 1% of the total DNA).

EFET requested immediate recall / withdrawal of the total of the above product from the market, while relevant controls are under way always aiming to protect consumers in Greece.
