Product Recall Information Notice on sesame snack bar

Hellenic Food Authority (EFET) and more specifically its Regional Directorate in Crete, following consumer complaint, was informed about a sesame snack product, which presented **unacceptable organoleptic characteristics regarding taste (mould taste in the mouth)**. This finding was confirmed following official investigation of this case.

The implicated product has the trade name "Snacks Farma Pasteli with sesame" (in Greek: «Snacks Farma παστέλι με σουσάμι») in package of 60 gr, with lot number **331** and best before date **05-10-2014**.

The product is produced in Greece for the company "NTIMFIL EPE" (in Greek: «NTIMΦΙΑ Ε.Π.Ε») situated in 29 Souri str., Athens (in Greek: «Σουρή 29, Αθήνα»).

EFET requested the immediate recall/withdrawal of the implicated lot of the product. Relevant controls are already in progress by EFET.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product (photo is depicted below) are advised not to consume it on a precautionary basis.
