Product Recall Information Notice

Hellenic Food Authority (EFET) and more specifically its Regional Directorate of Epirus, following Official Food Control and in collaboration with the Veterinary Laboratory in Ioannina, requested the recall/withdrawal of smoked trout due to the presence of the pathogen microorganism *Listeria monocytogenes*.

The product being recalled is "Smoked fillet trout of Louros river" (in Greek: "Καπνιστή Πέστροφα φιλέτο πηγών Λούρου"), with best before date 14/06/2014, in plastic packages in vacuum, which is produced by the company "SMOKED FISH – E. TSIALOS & EPE (in Greek: "SMOKED FISH – E. ΤΣΙΑΛΙΟΣ & ΣΙΑ Ε.Ε.") situated in the 29th klm of the Ioannina-Athens National Road.

EFET requested the immediate recall/withdrawal of the implicated batch of the product by the company. Relevant controls are in progress.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product (photo is depicted below) are asked not to consume it.
