Product Recall Information Notice on "Fir Honey of Mainalos origin"

EFET's Regional Directorate in Attiki in collaboration with the Directorate of Rural Economy and Veterinary of the Prefecture Unit in Arcadia, Prefecture of Peloponnese and also with the Veterinary Laboratory in Chania, following sampling, found out the presence of antibiotics (tetracyclines) in fir honey.

The implicated product is "Fir Honey of Mainalos origin" (in Greek: "M $\epsilon\lambda$ i E λ α tης M α iv $\alpha\lambda$ ou"), with best before date 30.9.15, in package of 950g, produced by "K. Mouroutsos, Lagkadia Arkadias" (in Greek: "K. Moupoúτσος, Λ α γκ $\alpha\delta$ i α Αρκ $\alpha\delta$ i α ς"), which was characterized as non compliant with regard to safety to human health.

EFET requested the immediate recall/withdrawal of the above product. Relevant controls are in progress.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product are asked not to consume it. Photo of the product is given below.
