Product Recall Information Notice on plastic plates

Following official control by EFET and laboratory analysis by the General Chemical State Laboratory of plastic plates, EFET asked for the recall of plastic plates as non compliant for their use in contact with food. The product “plastic plates” bear a printed image on their surface. Printing inks may potentially migrate to food when these plates are used.

The implicated plastic plates are of Chinese origin and marketed in packages of four (individual) pieces, with Lot No HDG 279 N and imported by the company “JUMBO AEVE” (in Greek: “JUMBO ANΩNYMH EMΠOPIKH ETAIPEIA”) situated in 9 Kiprou str. and Hydras, Moschato (in Greek: “Κύπρου 9 & Ύδρας, Μοσχάτο”).

EFET requested the immediate recall/withdrawal of the above product by the above mentioned company. Relevant controls are in progress.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product (photo below) are asked not to use it.
