**Product Recall Information Notice on
children's flask**

Hellenic Food Authority (EFET) and more specifically its Regional Directorate in Attica, following further investigation on consumer complaint proceeded to official sampling of a children's flask in collaboration with the General Chemical State Laboratory.

The product was found to be unsuitable for use since extensive corrosion of the interior surface had been determined which can result in migration of foreign material and substances from the flask to its content (water).

The implicated product is a children's flask with the trade name "Children's flask MONSUNO" (in Greek: "Παιδικό παγούρι MONSUNO") with lot 92/1474 και item No 3874020, which is imported by the company «CREATIVE CONCEPTS HELLAS S.A.» (in Greek: "CREATIVE CONCEPTS HELLAS AE") situated at 188 Piraeus street and distributed in the market by the company "MAX STORES AVEE" (in Greek: "MAX STORES ABEE").

EFET requested the immediate recall/withdrawal of the above product by the above mentioned company. Relevant controls are in progress.

Consumers who have in their possession the aforementioned product (photo below) are asked not to use it.
